

## **Infection Control**

- 1. Hand hygiene Make sure to wash under your nails and cover all surfaces of the hand for at least 20 seconds. Also be mindful of fingernail length (1/4" is long)
- 2.PPE (Personal Protective Equipment) Gloves, Mask
- 3. Respiratory hygiene -Cough etiquette decrease transmission

## **Standard Precautions for all Patient Care Transmission:**

Based Precautions are used in addition to Standard Precautions for clients/patients with known or suspected infection.

Treat all Clients/patients as if they are infectious!



## **Medication Safety**

- 1. Make sure to follow directions as ordered.
- 2. Monitor for side effects.
- 3. Know allergies. Just because client states no allergies, allergic reactions can start quickly.
- 4. Make sure client is not pocketing meds.
- 5. Give plenty of H2O.
- 6. Remind client to take meds. Assist as needed but do not administer!
- 7. Make sure to have proper lighting for visibility.
- 8. Tell MD about alcohol & drug use.
- 9. Check with MD before stopping meds. Take required # of days.
- 10. Don't share.
- 11. Know interactions and read insert package given by Pharmacy. Pharmacist will consult on any new meds and any questions or concerns.
